

Seed Saving Tips 2022

Peppers

Saving the seeds from a pepper is easy! Follow these steps to save seeds from any variety. Use caution when handling hot/spicy peppers such as gloves to protect your skin.



To harvest the seeds:

1. Take an over ripened pepper, one that has turned colour and is starting to wrinkle.
2. Cut open the pepper and scoop out the seeds.
3. Let them dry out on a paper towel for a couple of day.
4. Store in an airtight container, placed in a cool, dark space.
