
Seed Saving Tips 2022



Tomato plants are in full bloom with a vibrant red and delicious crop!





To harvest the seeds:

- 1. Pick a very ripe tomato.
- 2. Cut open and scoop out seeds and pulp.
- 3. Place seeds and pulp in a jar and add some water.
- 4. Let sit at room temperature for a few days, stir once a day
- 5. Remove the seeds, and rinse.
- 6. Let the seeds dry for a couple of days before storing in an airtight container. Keep the container in a cool, dark place until you are ready to plant next spring!
