## Seed Saving Tips 2022

## Zucchini

Running out of recipe ideas for your zucchini crop?

This time of year, you may have over-ripened zucchini still on the vine. The leaves will have died down and the zucchini has started to turn yellow or orange. This is perfect for saving seeds!



## To harvest the seeds:

- 1. Cut open the hardened zucchini
- 2. Scoop out the seeds
- 3. Rinse the seeds in water, separating out the flesh from the seeds
- 4. Leave the seeds out to dry in a warm spot for 3 or 4 days
- 5. Store in an airtight container
